Create a flower

You will need:

- 1 pipe cleaner (for stem)
- Some yarn (for roots)
- Crayons or markers (soil, cloud, rain, sun)
- Construction paper (for leaves)
- Cupcake holder (for flower)
- Sunflower seeds (for seeds)

Before you start:

• Read the paper about parts of a flower and what they do

Make your flower:

- Fold the pipe cleaner in half, then twist it and glue it to the paper (for the stem)
- Cut out some leaves and glue them onto the stem
- Cut some short pieces of yarn (roots) and glue or tape them to the bottom of the
- Flatten the cupcake holder and cut 1 inch slits around the side to make petals
- Tape or glue the cupcake holder (flower) to the top of the stem
- Place a small puddle of glue in the center of the cupcake holder and sprinkle in the sunflower seeds
- Above the flower, draw a cloud with raindrops, and a sun
- Draw a line just above the roots to show where the soil is
- Cut out the labels and tape or glue them to your picture to show the parts of a flower and what they do



- White construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape



- 1. The roots suck in water and nutrients to feed the plant
- 2. The stem moves water and nutrients up to the leaves and the flower
- 3. The leaves take energy from the sunlight to make food for the plant
- 4. The flower makes new seeds
- 5. Seeds make new plants
