





Auburn Farmers Market 2024 Currency Guide

At the Auburn Farmers Market we use several different types of currency. Most vendors accept credit cards, debit cards, checks, and of all vendors accept cash. All eligible vendors accept EBT tokens and SNAP Market Match that can be obtained by the customer at the information booth. Please read below for details about how to accept each token and voucher. Please remember:

- Turn in your currency at the end of each Market day
- Vendors will be reimbursed via check from the City twice monthly
- If a **new employee or friend** is covering your booth, it is your responsibility to make sure they are aware of which tokens to accept.
- You **will not** be reimbursed for mistakenly accepted tokens.
- **Never** give tokens back to a customer as change.
- When no change is allowed for a token, please **work with shoppers** to even out their total or have the customer supplement tokens with cash.
