The static display may be an informational booth, equipment, military vehicles, canine unit, historical display or any other display relating to veterans or military. Display check-in is from 7:00am-9:00a.m. Further information will be mailed to you in late October. This is not the official parade entry form; this form is ONLY for those wishing to provide a display.
