

2020 | Waste Management Bulky Item Collection Event

For City of Auburn Mobile Home Park Residents

Auburn's annual Bulky Item Collection is a once-a-year opportunity to clean house and get rid of your bulky items that are non-hazardous, non-liquid, and non-reusable at the curb or alley.

Collection is one day only
on your regular garbage day
April 13-17, 2020

Who can participate?

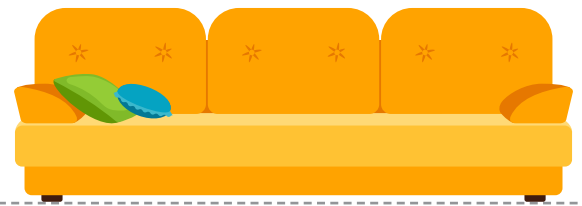
- Residents who live in a **mobile home park** within the Auburn city limits.
 - Residents who are Waste Management customers.
- Apartments (three or more units) and businesses are not included in the Bulky Item Collection program.

How do I prepare for collection?

- Place bulky Items in front of your mobile home by **7am on garbage collection day** the week of April 13-17, 2020.
- **Limit four items total.** One item allowed per category. See categories and list of accepted items on the backside of flyer. (Example: 1 dishwasher, 1 BBQ, 1 recliner chair, 1 child car seat).
- Be sure items are not blocking garbage, compostables and/or recycle containers.



- **Set out at your own risk.** Keep items not meant for pick up away from bulky items. The City of Auburn and Waste Management cannot be responsible for items picked up that were not meant for the Bulky Item Collection.
- Regular garbage, compostables and/or recycle collection will be picked up on the normal schedule during Bulky Item Collection week.



What if my items were not picked up?

- Multiple trucks will be picking up items.
- Bulky Item Collection driver will leave an "OOPS TAG" for items not accepted. Please remove these items from collection area.
- If there is NO "OOPS TAG" and your items have not been picked up by 7 p.m., contact your Property Manager the next day as soon as possible. The Property Manager will call the City of Auburn within 24 hours to report the missed pickup. Missed pickup items will be scheduled for collection within two business days. Leave items out to be collected.

- Electric or Non-motorized Mower

- Love Seat
- Mattress & Box Spring (Set)
- Ottoman
- Recliner Chair
- Sectional Sofa
- Small Entertainment Center
- Table & Chairs (Set)

CATEGORY 4 OTHER ITEMS

- Artificial Christmas Tree
- Bicycle
- Child Car Seat
- Child Stroller
- Exercise Bike
- Treadmill or Elliptical
- Vacuum Cleaner

NOT ACCEPTED

NO small or miscellaneous items, household garbage, yard waste or household hazardous waste.

NO wood/lumber, carpets/padding/flooring/rugs, TVs, electronics, remodeling/construction materials (doors, screens, windows, toilets, sinks, showers/tubs, cabinets, etc.)

NO gas mowers, chain saws or any other items that use fluids or gas.
